Maintain aircraft control

- FLY THE AIRPLANE! (**Aviate, Navigate, Communicate**)
- Stabilize & trim the aircraft

Analyze the situation

- Pause to understand the situation
- Do not jump to conclusions
- Evaluation options

Take the appropriate actions

- Execute BOLD face (immediate, time-sensitive actions)
- Reference & run the emergency checklist(s)
- Choose & execute the best course of action

To be applied during emergency situations.

Emergencies or Challenging Situations

#1

Aviate

- FLY THE AIRPLANE!
- Stabilize & trim the aircraft

#2

Navigate

- Point the nose in the right direction
- Dial up NAVAIDS as required

#3

Communicate

- Advise of your situation and intentions
- Co-pilot, passengers, other aircraft, ATC

To be applied IN THIS PRIORITIZED ORDER at any time, during any phase of flight, especially during emergencies.
