## Emergencies

Maintain aircraft control

- FLY THE AIRPLANE! (Aviate, Navigate, Communicate)
- Stabilize & trim the aircraft

Analyze the situation

- Pause to understand the situation
- Do not jump to conclusions
- Evaluation options

Take the appropriate actions

- Execute BOLD face (immediate, time-sensitive actions)
- Reference & run the emergency checklist(s)
- Choose & execute the best course of action

To be applied during emergency situations.

Aviate, Navigate, Communicate Emergencies or Challenging Situations	
<u>#1</u> Aviate	- FLY THE AIRPLANE! - Stabilize & trim the aircraft
<u>#2</u> Navigate	<ul> <li>Point the nose in the right direction</li> <li>Dial up NAVAIDS as required</li> </ul>
<u>#3</u> Communicate	<ul> <li>Advise of your situation and intentions</li> <li>Co-pilot, passengers, other aircraft, ATC</li> </ul>

To be applied IN THIS PRIORITIZED ORDER at any time, during any phase of flight, especially during emergencies.
